# GSA One Acquisition Solution for Integrated Services – (OASIS)



## Contract Overview

The General Services Administration (GSA) One Acquisition Solution for Integrated Services (OASIS) contract is designed to address agencies' needs for a full range of service requirements that integrate multiple professional service disciplines and ancillary services/products with the flexibility for all contract types and pricing at the task order level.

The objective of OASIS is to provide government agencies with total integrated solutions for a multitude of professional service-based requirements on a global basis. The services to be provided under OASIS are intended to meet the professional service mission requirements of all federal agencies, including all organizations within the Department of Defense (DoD) and the national security community.

### Program Management Services

Leading, facilitating, and ensuring the strategic planning, implementation, coordination, integration, and evaluation of programmatic activities and administrative systems.

## GSA OASIS/OASIS SB Highlights

- Standardized Labor Categories: 127 SOC occupations among 26 OASIS LCATs and covering over 1,000 traditional industry job titles
- Reduced administrative burden and acquisition lead time
- 2 GWAC IDIQ contract vehicles: OASIS Unrestricted & OASIS Small Business
- 7 “Pools” in each contract vehicle
- Each pool defined by different NAICS codes
- Each pool has ~40 companies per contract vehicle
- OASIS SB pools include socio-economic categories: 8(a), SDVOSB, WOSB, HUBZone
- OASIS SB contract allows 8(a) direct awards & SDVOSB set asides
- Task orders competed within a single contract vehicle and single pool
- Companies only receive & respond to RFI/RFP released in their pool(s)
- 541330 NAICS is associated with:
  - SB Pool 1: \$15M size standard
  - SB Pool 3: \$38.5M size standard (military exceptions)

## CSA OASIS Pool 3 Contract Holder
